1. Your mission now is very clear

Unless you find his Daddy's haul  
You'll be travelling star systems both old and new  
But how to navigate, you haven't a clue  
If you access the data banks, for your pilgrimage  
You'll find the nearest starbase in a quaint village  
Your **Betazed** friend can help you now  
She feels an "island" presence somehow  
Your future travels you cannot evade  
Back in your time, you'd need an aide
2. You've gained information, but not enough  
A coastal journey ahead could prove very rough  
The crew must think of a logical place  
Where Khan could hide treasure without a trace  
Kirk's old ship is a good place to start  
But how to get there is the tricky part  
Southward now, past **Planet Vulcan**,  
Several miles will you curve and run  
Then up you'll jet on the Hawthorne Way  
The vessel's location is not far away  
On your left, up the hill near the top  
You'll find the coordinates of your stop
3. The treasure's not here! But you can't delay  
Now's not the time for feet of clay  
But to search the galaxy for Khan's treasure  
Involves distances and times you can't even measure  
There must be a clue about where to begin  
And the answer might be in this ship of tin

You know the crew abandoned ship  
In order to give the Klingons the slip  
Maybe if you retraced their route  
You'll discover the hidden loot  
To follow the voyage, resume your course

The a path you're on is green and verdant  
Your heading is south, and your mission is urgent

4. Dammit! The past provides no clue  
To tell which path you should pursue  
You must find a way to piece together  
The puzzle of this hidden treasure  
The problem: the universe is so vast  
His location is impossible to forecast!  
At least the computer is sophisticated  
To make the process less complicated  
You'll fly in the Enterprise past other ships  
Now take the Bridge, and let 'er rip!  
Keep steady in your southward motion  
Before too **Long**, you'll reach the **Ocean**  
Here at last, the computer will start  
To take an important, active part

5. You've started to narrow down the choices  
And listened to the computer voices  
Perhaps the escape pod holds a clue  
About the battle that did ensue  
If Khan left a record for his son  
About the battle he wished we'd won  
The log may contain a secret code  
To decipher when he was old  
Out past Earth, and Jupiter soon  
You'll reach the frozen orb of Neptune  
You must change coordinates and leave the Ocean  
You're the ensign - plot a course for Route 1  
South again your ship must travel  
If Khan's mystery you're to unravel

Why this outpost is unclear  
Although a weapons station is near

6. The treasure's not here! Is all lost?  
You must find more clues at any cost  
The next leg of your journey will be quite a trek  
But don't retreat to ten forward's deck  
Further south still, if you're deft  
Then on Warner, you'll take a left  
Follow until you see a glow  
Much like a sunset (the crew will know)  
Hard to port if you're still game  
A college in this world will bear the same name  
Your technology guided you to this star  
(If you see Dr. Crusher, you've gone too far!)  
A view of a map will bring some order  
If you look through your tricorder

7. Now you know you're on the right track  
But the treasure you still lack  
Data knows to what land Khan refers  
A primitive people, mostly Hunters  
The quickest route and most direct  
Is named for the locale it will intersect  
If you're wise, you'll know it's west  
Where Khan's next instructions do rest  
Time to fly to this hinterland

(found a Beta Travel - leads to rocket in PV Park)

2. You've come here to help mankind  
So now it's time to use your mind  
To paraphrase Spock, it would be logical  
To begin where Khan put up this obstacle  
Now you must venture boldly  
To Kirk's ship, now old and moldy  
Here you can aid the new Enterprise  
Who, though advanced, may not be wise  
For an old-fashioned version of a space ship  
Might give the less experienced a slip  
You'll recognize this Park of the galaxy  
Up near the stars in Rancho PV  
Gravity here you will now defy  
When you climb up to the sky

(found at rocket, leads to Cabrillo museum)

3. **Captain's log, Star Date 121.7...**

"We escaped the Klingons, but lost Mr. Spock  
Inside the radioactive lock  
Now we've regained our logical friend  
But the Klingons surprised us at the end  
We took their vessel, then journeyed home  
No longer carefree, we could not roam  
We broke many rules in coming here  
And now must face a jury of peers  
But on the way to Earth we encountered  
A threat that could not be surmounted  
The foe was violent, huge and strong  
But in fact, they sang a song  
To save the Earth, we went back in time  
To heed the Ancient Mariner's rhyme."  
To make Kirk and Khan even-Steven  
Your White knuckled flight should now be leavin'  
You must retrace Kirk's valiant quest  
At Cabrillo, your catch does rest  
At the entry you pay no fee  
And don't be embarrassed - touching is free

(found at Cabrillo - leads to LB Library)

5. This log from Khan's ship provides a hand

To see the shuttle he waved goodbye  
The message from his ship gives you direction  
So you can set your next trajectory  
Plot in your course, the computer will know  
Leaving LB's system, past SB you go  
The civilization here looks fairly backward  
But to your right, the shuttle was lured  
When you pass the 5th sector you'll know  
You have much less than a parsec to go  
The King may welcome you for a beer  
But do not forget why you're here!

*Captain's Log, Mariposa, Star Date 171.15  
My son, I hope you understand  
Why I sent you to a new land  
This battle with Kirk does not go well  
His attacks I cannot repel  
But before my ship I self-destruct

(at Neptune - leads to Golden West College)

6. The away team now takes on the mission  
To follow those clues left in derision  
Dock at base 26, and then you'll find  
A guide was plainly left behind  
**Technology** always fascinated Khan

To follow him, you must cross the lawn  
The turbo lift here is made of glass  
But autostop will save your ass  
Use this disk to spy your location  
Closing one eye helps your concentration  
You'll see the coordinates of this domain  
But a second look gives specific terrain

(found at Golden west, leads to beach)

7. My son, I assume it must be you  
Only my heir would understand my clue  
I arranged the help of many a friend  
To determine where my treasure would end  
A primitive people helped me most  
You will find them on the coast  
Their rockets and probes were very crude  
But they repaid me with servitude  
One did try to challenge me  
But I dealt with him quite severely  
You see him hanging by his toes  
In an alloy, his body I froze  
When you hit PCH, a right will do  
His corpse will serve as a marker true  
The 2nd probe has encoded instructions for you  
So my wealth you'll know how to accrue  
Son, in order to improve your lot  
Find out where X marks the spot

(found at shuttle at Beach - leads to Newport Holograms)

8. Son, I'll admit I made a mistake  
When a certain officer's life I did take  
The Vulcan people are quite wise  
Without the emotions that jeopardize  
To find one who can edify  
My past error you must rectify  
Don't try the Spock that lives in your time  
Go back for the Vulcan in his prime  
For he was not only intelligent  
But he was there when my treasure was sent  
Although he took that secret to his grave  
His memory was lost, when his body was saved  
This alien's image you will find  
It's up to you to revive his mind  
Go south now, and fight the traffic  
To get technology holographic  
You can look through Binoculars and Telescope  
For behind it all will be the hope  
That *discreetly* Spock you can retrieve  
For the information you must receive

(found at Holograms - leads to Scary Dark Ride)

9.            You brought Spock back, but victory is hollow  
              A dangerous path you must now follow  
              Khan was protective of his treasure  
              He added traps for extra measure  
              Though hidden, they are still dangerous  
              And make space travel perilous  
              The explosives you must quickly locate  
              Further south you navigate  
              You studied all sorts of explorers in school  
              From Balboa to Armstrong, you thought they were cool  
              Now you're travelling among the stars  
              And you fear you may get battle scars  
              No need to be scared, though the ride may be dark  
              You just need a place for the Enterprise to park  
              A left at Main will leave you at bay  
              Now you're walking distance away  
              Take a landing party of more than one  
              For your next ride may not be fun  
              Beware of dynamite on your right  
              As it falls, it gives quite a fright

**FINAL :**    You complete a dangerous flight  
              But now the treasure is within sight  
              You've heard of illusions that seem real  
              The Ocean's a Front, and does conceal  
              The treasure is there, waiting for the right one  
              You can now give it to Khan's son  
              Back up Balboa, from whence you came  
              Soon Khan's fortune you can claim
