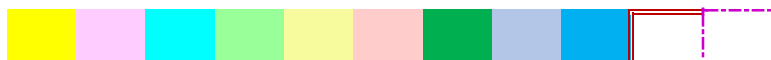
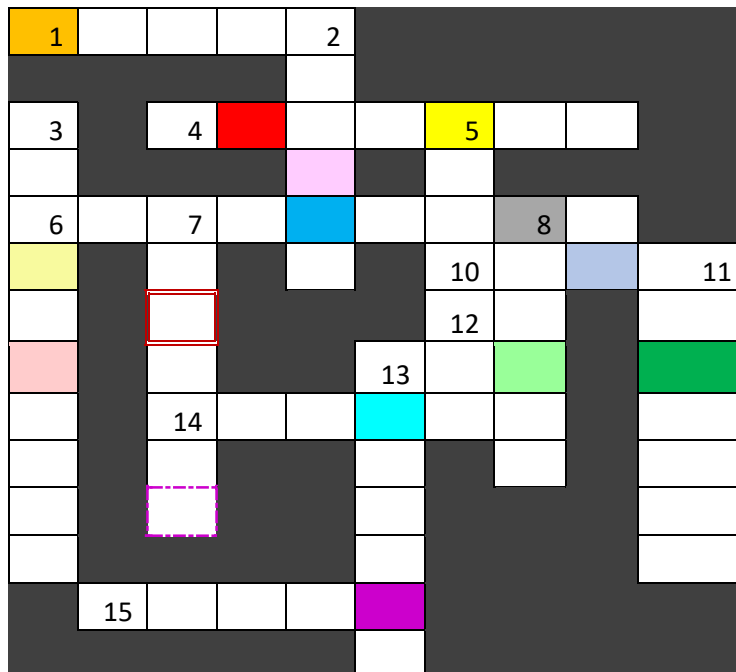


From nasty orcs our hobbits make their escape

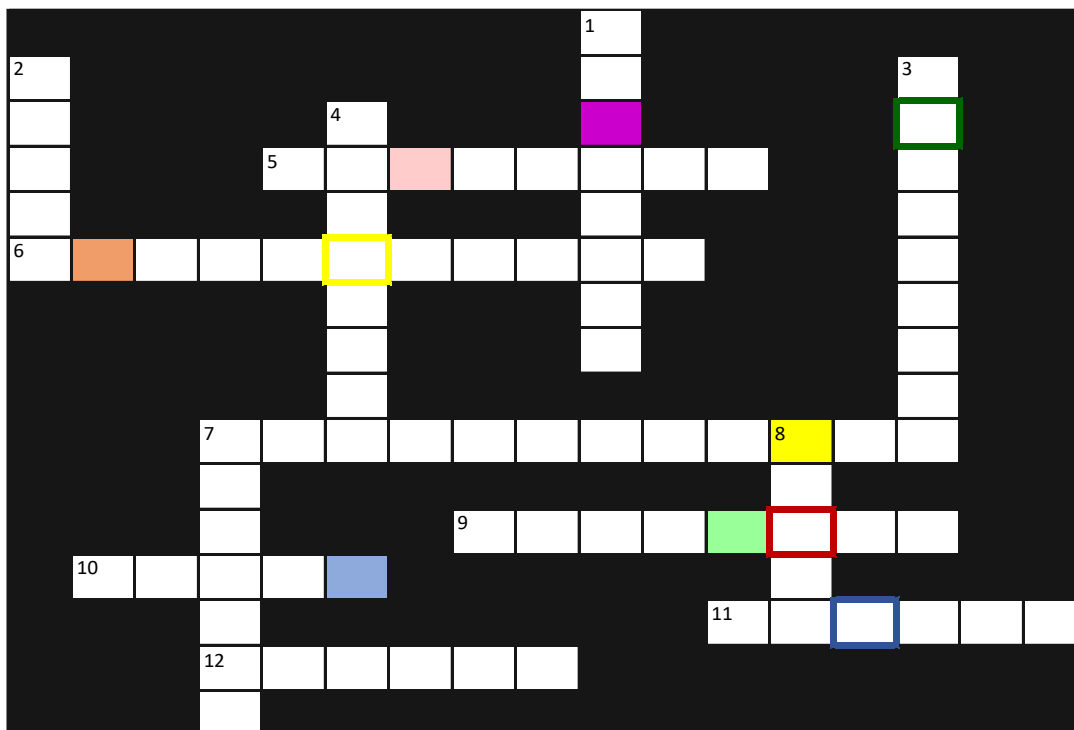
