



WELCOME TO THE LAND OF NEVERWONDEROZ



nce upon a time, three young girls were frustrated and bored with their own homes. Sweet, simple Dorothy wanted to run away from Kansas and mean old Miss Gulch who wanted to destroy little Toto. Curious Alice, uninterested in her sisters' books, just wanted something to do. Romantic prepubescent Wendy had dreams of a little adventure with the roguish-yet-forever-young PETER PAN, far away from dreary London. Then *deus ex machina!* Dorothy is whisked over the rainbow by a twister, bringing her to the Land of Oz – with Munchkins, wizards, and talking trees. Alice follows the White Rabbit down the rabbit hole, eats magic cakes, and enters Wonderland. Peter and faery Tinkerbell visit Wendy, sprinkle a little pixie dust, and away they fly to Neverland. And as all young film lovers know, each soon wanted to go back home.



ut how? Our young heroines are now trapped and beset by danger. Lions, and tigers, and bears – oh my! Will the Wicked Witch and her Winkies kill Dorothy for those slippers? Alice is both lost and facing the perils of changing sizes and capricious royalty. Off with her head? But she likes it attached! Wendy is facing both a jealous Tinkerbell and savage pirates, led by the nefarious Captain Hook. She can't fly home – she's out of dust and doesn't know the way. And as Dorothy told the Good Witch Glinda, she can't very well leave the same way she came in. They need you, Brave Malliers, to bring them home. You have been brought to Colorado to enter NeverWonderOz and rescue the girls. Each team has a passport. You must stamp the passports with as many of our stamps as you can to succeed in your journey. You must also pick up your team's party animal. Every team has the same 22 clues – 7 for each heroine and one mandatory stop – plus an interactive clue unique to each team. ONE stamp will be at each site; each team stamps its own passport and leaves the stamp†. Nine animals will be at the sites, one for each team. Don't pick up the wrong ones! If you actually get to all twenty-three sites then you are smarter than the Scarecrow and faster than Tinkerbell. You will undoubtedly need to make choices in order to maximize your points. A few clues are worth more points; additionally, if you complete all the clues for a particular heroine you receive bonus points. Luckily for you a Fairy Godmother/Good Witch/Wizard has provided a few hints on each clue:



- In the upper left of each clue is a symbol for which storyline the clue fits. Your unique interactives are x3; a few clues will also have a +2.
- In the upper right of each clue, the White Rabbit holds a watch with different times. While the hands point to specific times (12p, 3p, 5p), please note that these are general times designed to help you plan your route and zones. A few clues do have more specific times

noted, so we suggest actually reading your clues.



- In the lower left is an icon for walking or driving. This lets you know if a particular clue is within walking distance of another. Now obviously you will have to drive to at least one of the walking clues in a group, otherwise you will never leave Westminster. Again, this helps you sort and plan. Don't think we can make it much simpler, except to say use your noggin.

As usual, points will be deducted for calls. Because you will receive more clues than you can do in the time allotted, we highly discourage calling if you get stuck on one (or two) clues. This is a nonlinear rally, so at **5:00p** we will text teams and let you know which envelope to open for the final destination. ([This means we need to know whom on your team to text.](#)) At that point you will have 2½ hours to get to The Castle – points will be deducted if you arrive after **7:30p**.

Your party animal will correspond to your team name and buttons. **Caveats:** 1) Not all the animals for each team look identical; these are not clones. The Cheshire Cats have cats of different colors, but always house cats. The White Rabbit usually has rabbits that are not white; the Fairies are different sizes and shapes; Lions & Tigers &... have both lions and tigers. If this doesn't make sense ask us now before you leave. 2) A few sites do not have animals planted; you must photograph yourself with one (or make one). This is always noted in the clue sheet. 3) Just because you see three animals under a plant and your animal isn't with them does *not* necessarily mean your animal is missing. Some plants are smaller than others, so animals are sometimes separated under different plants/stones/whatnots. If you really believe your animal is missing, take a photo of where you thought it should be. The animals will be really important in case of a tie on passport stamps.

Do not pick up another team's animal!! To make sure you know what is yours and what is not, below are the team animals:

You must wear your Peter Pan hats and T-shirts while you Rally. But you knew this already. ☺

You must take a photo at each clue site, and at least 2 team members should be in the photo. Bonus points if all team members are in the shot. As always, bonus points if you get a photo of another team without their hats.

No bonus points for arriving an hour early, unless you are the miracle team who actually completed all of your clues with time to spare. Then yes, bonus points. That said, bonus points for finishing early are smaller than you think, so it's not worth driving like a maniac (Chip Moore). The roads getting closer to the Castle can be a little hazardous, so **no drinking and driving**. Obey all traffic laws. Obey all state laws. (This means no lighting a joint outside on a public sidewalk.)

† **Very Important Note re stamps:** Do not remove stamps from their location!! Stamps can work one of three ways:

1. Stamp is affixed to a surface. **Do not peel off the stamp.** Press your inkpad against the stamp, then your passport against the stamp, and voilà! Stamp doesn't even move.
2. Stamp is loose. Pick up stamp, stamp passport, return stamp to original location.
3. Stamp is tied (via string) to something. **Leave stamp on the string.** Inkpad, stamp, passport... ¡Olé!
