

Ajaw, is the sacred daysign and nawal of the Sun. It represents mental and psychological tests and challenges, struggle, leadership and heroism. It also embodies the energy and strength of completion. Ajaw's animal totems are the eagle and the human being.

There is a pink and a yellow ribbon hidden at each of three nearby locations within eyesight of the starting area, and it is up to you to choose which one to pursue. Only a single member of each team at a time can leave the designated area to search for a ribbon. The others must remain in bounds, but are free to offer all the encouragement, admonishments or instructions they wish. If two or more members of a team are outside the boundary, they must all immediately stop and return to within bounds before a single member can begin their search once more.

Be the first to return with a pink ribbon and you will receive your clue bag and are free to be on your way. The second team to return with a pink ribbon may not leave until no fewer than five minutes has elapsed since the first team left. The third team, five minutes after the previous. The first yellow ribbon back leaves five minutes after the third pink, and so on until the last. In the unlikely event that a team takes more than five minutes than the previous team to return with a ribbon, they are free to leave immediately.

Any team seen pushing, kicking or exhibiting any other sort of unsportsmanlike behavior to another team will be held for 10 minutes behind the last fair playing to go out.

Your three clues are:

- At Paradise Villas take an even longer walk on a long pier.
- Leave no seat unturned in an alliteratively damp ding-a-ling.
- Against a backdrop of brown in a place with no name, a colorful prize should be simple to claim.
