Quickly picture the host of the game

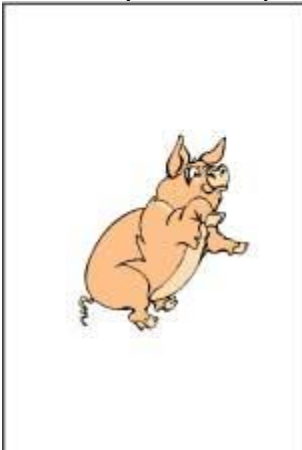
Bird 8
